

Career Life Connection 12 Capstone: The COVID 19 Edition

This version of the Capstone project continues to ask you to reflect on and celebrate your past, and present, and to demonstrate planning for your future. This project continues to be an opportunity for you to share and celebrate YOURSELF! The following provides you additional guidance for your Capstone and gives some information about the presentation format.

Plan and Prepare

- Keep planning as we discussed it in class.
- Compile pictures and artifacts (physical objects – you can take pictures of these and put them into your presentation)
- Prepare a slideshow/ppt/prezi/emaze presentation - these presentation platforms will allow you to add video/audio.
- Another option is to create a series of posters.
- You may also create a video.

You should ensure that you give equal weighting to each section of your presentation. Your past/present/future should all include a variety of information. Remember what we discussed in class, try to focus on:

- the qualities/skills/knowledge you have gained and are gaining
- the planning you have done for the future – how you have planned for the next 5 years/10 years

Present

In light of the current situation, this part will be very different, but also the same. You are still expected to create a Capstone presentation.

- Video yourself presenting or add audio to your presentation (voice over). Free software, like Screencast-O-Matic, allows you to audio record yourself while going through the presentation (you click through your presentation and record yourself reading the script you have prepared). Google also has different methods of recording (these can be recommended, if need be).

- Video yourself presenting posters/theatrical performance/giving a demonstration.
- Google Meet – this will include doing your presentation live on Google Meet. You will be guided in advance on how to share your presentation, if you want to use a slide presentation.
- Other – this will need to be discussed with Ms. Falck and must not require being physically present (all options must be virtual).

Your presentation is expected to last between 10-15 minutes (rather than the original 20-25 minutes).

Submitting Your Capstone

- A Google Classroom titled ‘Capstone’ will be created for all students.
- Please complete the Google Form on the Google Classroom (both in assignments and posted on the stream). In this form, you can request up to three teachers to comment/view your presentation. Please note that requests are not guaranteed. We will do our best to accommodate you. Please answer all questions and respond to the Google Form by APRIL 27th (this is very important for students wishing to present live).
- You will submit your assignment the same way you would submit any other assignment on Google classroom.
- Google Meets will happen when they are scheduled. If you have created a video/audio/taken pictures, please submit these in a folder on the Google classroom.
- Repeat: Google Form MUST BE COMPLETED BY APRIL 27TH – “FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE”. Also, be aware, if you do not complete the form, you’ll not have choice about who ‘views’ your Capstone.

Feedback on Your Capstone

- Feedback will be given virtually.
- All feedback will be sent directly to your assignment, which will be submitted online.
- If presenting live, you will be given feedback via email, following your presentation.
