- 5. Treasurer's Report
- General Account \$1363.91 (\$966.45 available for regular spending, the rest is earmarked for breakfast/lunch programming)
 - Gaming \$13,562.41
- In response to the parent question at the last meeting, Jennifer looked into the time frame that gaming funds must be spent in . We have two years to spend the yearly allocation.
 - The gaming funds should be deposited in October some time. Estimated funds are \$11,620.00

6. Principal's Report - Darryl Adams

- Two school wide events have occurred over the last month. A Terry Fox run/walk was held. As well, a Day for Truth and Reconcilliation took place. Thanks to the PAC for the assistance with the pancake breakfast.
- Alberta and BC post secondary institutions visits happened last week.
- Thirteen days of hot lunch have been served with a total of 491 meals. Parent volunteers are assisting in the service of the food prepared by the Foods classes.
- The district superintendent visited last Tuesday. The PAC met with her and had a discussion asking many good questions. Darryl has a few areas that he will follow up with from the conversation.
- Hardship funds have been allocated. Families needing support with school fees and other costs should contact Darryl. Reminder that there is also The KidSport grant that can be accessed for school sports.
- No specific allocation for transportation has been communicated yet.

- Feeding Futures Grant has been allocated and the amount is more than last year's, but there is no staffing attached to the funding this year. Food items are available from Rm 109.
